REQUEST FOR THE PRESCRIPTION OF PROVISIONAL MEASURES UNDER ARTICLE 290, PARAGRAPH 1, OF THE UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION ON THE LAW OF THE SEA

ORDER

The President of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea (hereinafter "the Tribunal"),

Having regard to article 290, paragraph 1, of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (hereinafter "the Convention"),

Having regard to articles 25 and 27 of the Statute of the Tribunal,

Having regard to articles 45 and 90, paragraph 2, of the Rules of the Tribunal,

Having regard to the Application submitted by Luxembourg to the Tribunal on 4 June 2024 instituting proceedings against Mexico,

Having regard to the Request submitted by Luxembourg on 7 June 2024 for the prescription of provisional measures by the Tribunal in accordance with article 290, paragraph 1, of the Convention,

Having ascertained the views of the Parties,

Fixes 11 and 12 July 2024 as the dates for the hearing;

Reserves the subsequent procedure for further decision.

Done in English and in French, both texts being equally authoritative, in the Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg, this thirteenth day of June two thousand and twenty-four, in three copies, one of which will be placed in the archives of the Tribunal and the others transmitted to the Government of Luxembourg and the Government of Mexico, respectively.
