THE "ZHENG HE" CASE (LUXEMBOURG V. MEXICO), PROVISIONAL MEASURES

SOLEMN DECLARATION BY JUDGES *AD HOC*ON 10 JULY 2024 AT 12 NOON

The Tribunal will hold a public sitting in *The "Zheng He" Case (Luxembourg v. Mexico)* on Wednesday, 10 July 2024, at 12 noon, during which the judges *ad hoc* chosen by Luxembourg and Mexico will make the solemn declaration required under article 9 of the Rules of the Tribunal. Luxembourg has nominated Mr Marcelo Kohen to serve as judge *ad hoc* and Mr Alberto Székely y Sánchez has been nominated by Mexico.

The hearing in *The "Zheng He" Case (Luxembourg v. Mexico), Provisional Measures* will take place on 11 and 12 July 2024. The schedule of the hearing is available on the <u>website</u> of the Tribunal.

The sitting will take place in the main courtroom of the Tribunal and is open to the public. Members of the diplomatic and consular corps, the general public and representatives of the media wishing to attend the sitting are requested to register in advance with the Press Office.
