The International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea will once again be participating in the City of Hamburg's "Long Night of the Consulates" on Wednesday, 30 April 2025, opening its doors to the general public from 5:30 p.m. to 9 p.m.



Visitors will have the opportunity to tour the building, the courtroom and the restored nineteenth-century Villa Schröder, and learn about the work of the Tribunal. The Tribunal will be open to visitors from 5:30 p.m., with final entry at 8:30 p.m. Valid photo identification is required to enter the venue.
